Illinois' capital forms the heart of Abraham Lincoln country. Visitors can tour the 16th president's home, law offices and Old State Capitol where he served in the legislature. View the Lincoln Library and Museum. Pay



your respects at Lincoln's Tomb. Visit the New Salem State Historic Site. Here, costumed guides re-create the 1830s town where the future president lived and worked.

Southeast of the city, this KOA offers a quiet country setting with covered Tent Sites, level pull thrus and deluxe cabins. Head to Lake Springfield for boating and fishing. Nostalgia buffs: Don't leave without getting your kicks on Route 66, where you'll find a museum, shops, motorcycle races, antique car rallies and a drive-in diner. Relax at KOA's pool, and enjoy the mini golf and bike rentals. Check out the remodeled covered deck and Kamp K9 for your furry friends. Kids (and adults!) love the Jumping Pillow.
