



# Camping at Starved Rock State Park

Utica, Illinois



May 19 – 21, 2017

Starved Rock State Park Campground is set in a semi-wooded area just a short 1 ½ hour drive north on I-39 near the community of Utica, Illinois. Here is a link to their website:

Starved Rock State Park Campground is maintained to provide camping in a natural setting as part of the outdoor recreational experience. Each campsite has electricity, a gravel parking space, a picnic table, and a metal burn grill.

Besides excellent hiking opportunities during our stay, of which proper footwear and even a walking stick is highly recommended, trolley tours are being offered during our visit. The trolley tour is available on Saturday, 5/20/17 from 3:00-4:30. The trolley tour includes a stop at the State Park Visitor Center for a short video, a stop at the Illinois Waterway Visitor Center to view the river, and a short drive through the town of Utica.

A river cruise may also be available. If interested, please see the park website and call for a reservation.
