



2017 Co-ed Ultimate Frisbee Summer League

June 8 – July 27 at State Farm Park

Ultimate Frisbee combines the non-stop movement of soccer with the passing skills of football in a fast-paced game played with a Frisbee. Ultimate is a transition game where everyone moves quickly from offense to defense as in soccer and requires a combination of agility, speed and shenanigans to play. It is a non-contact sport that is governed by the Spirit of the Game™, a tradition of sportsmanship that places the responsibility for fair play on the players rather than referees.

Co-ed teams consist of five players on the field with at least one male and one female playing at all times. At least 10 players are recommended per team due to the physical exertion required to play. While there is no maximum number of players per team, there is a maximum award amount of \$240.00 for a first place team and \$180.00 for a second place team. Each team will receive an official Discraft Ultrastar Ultimate Disc to play with and return to SFEA after season end.

The league includes recreational and competitive divisions, as long as enough competitive players sign up. Sign up details:

- Recreational players can sign up as teams or as individuals to be placed on a team.
- The competitive players can sign up as individuals ONLY and a draft will be held to build teams if enough players sign up. If a player puts their name in for the competitive league draft, but is not picked up by a competitive league team, they will be placed on recreational league team.

Game times: Thursday at 5:30pm (typically competitive) and 6:30pm (typically recreational). Due to possible conflicts with Play Day clean-up, the first week of games on 6/8 may be rescheduled to a later date.

Enrollment closes on May 18. All SFEA members (including non-employee spouses and dependents) in high school are eligible to participate in this league but if in high school, are not eligible for awards. SFEA member cost is \$3.00.

Teams are allowed up to (2) non SFEA members on each team as a guest of an SFEA player on that team. Cost for non SFEA members is \$8. Violation of membership privileges (signing up those NOT on your membership or additional guests) could lead to your SFEA membership being revoked. If you are unsure of your membership benefits or who is included as a member, please contact the SFEA office.
