Season tickets to the theatre are \$56 for SFEA members and \$63 for guests. Tickets are good for all six shows. Performance dates are listed in the description for each show. Accompanying your SFEA receipt will be a ticket voucher from Community Players. When you have selected the performance you wish to attend, send it to the theatre box office and they will return your tickets. All productions are held at the theatre, located at 201 Robinhood Lane in Bloomington. Enrollment closes on June 6. The number of season tickets you may purchase at the member price is indicated by the last two digits of your SFEA number. An employee SFEA member may bring any or all dependent family members (listed on their membership) at the member price **OR** one guest at the **member price**. *Violation of membership privileges (signing up those NOT on your membership) could lead to your SFEA membership being revoked. If you are unsure of your membership benefits or who is included as a member, please contact the SFEA office.* **The event is limited to 400 SFEA member season tickets.** An unlimited amount of guest tickets may be purchased. ### Boeing Boeing (Comedy)

**Performances: September 2-4 & 9-11, 2016**

This 1960's French farce adapted for the English-speaking stage features self-styled Parisian lothario Bernard, who has Italian, German, and American fiancées, each beautiful airline hostesses with frequent "layovers". He keeps "one up, one down and one pending" until unexpected schedule changes bring all three to Paris and Bernard's apartment at the same time.

### Avenue Q (Musical)

**Performances: November 4-6, 11-13 & 18-20, 2016**

Mature Audiences Only. The laugh-out-loud musical tells the timeless story of a recent college grad named Princeton who moves into a shabby New York apartment all the way out on Avenue Q. He soon discovers that although the residents seem nice, it's clear that this is not your ordinary neighborhood. Together, Princeton and his new-found friends struggle to find jobs, dates, and their ever-elusive purpose in life.

### A Streetcar Named Desire (Drama)

**Performances: January 13-15 & 20-22, 2017**

The play reveals to the very depths the character of Blanche du Bois, a woman whose life has been undermined by her romantic illusions, which lead her to reject—so far as possible—the realities of life with which she is faced and which she consistently ignores. The pressure brought to bear upon her by her sister, with whom she goes to live in New Orleans, intensified by the earthy and extremely "normal" young husband of the latter, leads to a revelation of her tragic self-delusion and, in the end, to madness.

### West Side Story (Musical)

**Performances: March 10-12, 17-19 & 24-26, 2017**

Set in the Upper West Side neighborhood in New York City in the mid-1950s, this musical explores the rivalry between the Jets and the Sharks, two teenage street gangs of different ethnic backgrounds. The members of the Sharks, from Puerto Rico, are taunted by the Jets. The young protagonist, Tony, a former member of the Jets and best friend of the gang leader, Riff, falls in love with Maria, the sister of Bernardo, the leader of the Sharks.

### The 39 Steps (Comedy)

**Performances: May 5-7 & 12-14, 2017**

Mix a Hitchcock masterpiece with a juicy spy novel, add a dash of Monty Python and you have The 39 Steps, a fast-paced whodunit for anyone who loves the magic of theatre! In The 39 Steps, a man with a boring life meets a woman with a thick accent who says she's a spy. When he takes her home, she is murdered. Soon, a mysterious organization called "The 39 Steps" is hot on the man's trail in a nationwide manhunt that climaxes in a death-defying finale!

### Disney's The Little Mermaid (Musical)

**Performances: July 7-9, 13-16 & 20-23, 2017**

Ariel, King Triton's youngest daughter, wishes to pursue the human Prince Eric in the world above and bargains with the evil sea witch, Ursula, to trade her tail for legs. But the bargain is not what it seems and Ariel needs the help of her colorful friends Flounder the fish, Scuttle the seagull, and Sebastian the crab to restore order under the sea.
