SFEA Good Neighbor Outdoor Club was founded in 1990. The purpose of the club is to encourage the appreciation for the outdoors through simple activities, exploration of natural areas, great adventures, and special educational presentations in addition to having fun with State Farm associates and their families outside the work place. For retirees, these activities provide the opportunity to keep in contact with friends and stay current with what is going on at State Farm.

Typically SFEA Outdoor Club sponsors and organizes one or two events for each month of the year. The membership fee is \$5.00 per year (individual or family), paid to SFEA. Participants must provide their own equipment, food, reservation and trip costs. Club funds are used to provide coffee, purchasing equipment that can be used for club activities, and other club-wide event costs.
