SFEA, in partnership with the **Outdoor Club**, is again offering the very popular Fishing Clinic for adult and child teams. The session will be about 3 hours long, with several stations set up to help increase knowledge about fish, fishing, and boost confidence with fishing skills. We will encourage catch & release throughout the morning. We hope that each child catches 1 or more fish!

Volunteers will be available to assist adult and child teams.

Participating teams need to consist of an adult and a child (5-16 years old). If you are interested in participating with a child, please mark on the enrollment form with the names of each set of adult/child teams. Children must be paired with their parent/adult, and no more than 2 kids per adult depending on age and needs. The cost to attend this clinic is **\$5 per child**.

Highly Recommended: Rod & Reel Maintenance!

Additional Opportunity: For children to get the most out of fishing it is not only about learning how to fish which the clinic will teach. Another key aspect of fishing is to remove frustrations due to fishing line that does not cast smoothly because it is more than a year old or reels that do not work well and just need a little maintenance. We are offering an opportunity to get your child's fishing pole ready for the clinic. Kids are welcome to attend with adult, and please bring a spool of new fishing, line 6 to 8lb-test. Please remember to **bring a fishing rod and reel for each child**. Kids tackle boxes are optional. Adults and kids ages 16 and older will need a **valid fishing license**. You can get a license at local sporting goods stores, or try online through the IL DNR License Sales at: <https://www1.il.wildlifelicense.com/license.php?action=custlkup>

An employee SFEA member may bring any or all dependent family members listed on his or her membership **OR** one guest. Violation of membership privileges (signing up those **NOT** on your membership) could lead to your SFEA membership being revoked.

Once selected to attend the event, we are unable to provide a refund. In the event that demand exceeds available capacity, a drawing will be conducted. Should the event go to a drawing, those not selected will be notified by email and their checks shredded in the HR secure shredder.
