

SFEA Co-Ed Soccer League 2017

State Farm Park

April 17 – August/September (contingent on the number of teams)

SFEA's co-ed 7-on-7 league is open for enrollment! Consisting of a double round-robin (home and away against each team), the league will last approximately 5 months with a four-team seeded playoff. Teams on the field will consist of two females and five males (six outfield players and one goalkeeper). SFEA members (including spouses and high school age dependents*) are eligible to participate in the league. In addition, up to two (2) non-SFEA guest players are allowed per team (must sign up with a team, no individuals). SFEA price is \$10, guest price is \$12.

Individual signups are encouraged and will be placed on a team.

Officials are always needed and are paid \$25 per game. Please email [Michael Perez](#) (NIK5), if you are interested.

All regularly scheduled games will be played **Monday** evenings at State Farm Park. Start times are **5:30 p.m. & 6:30 p.m.** (24-minute halves with 2-minute intermission), with times shifting forward 15 minutes during summer months to allow make-up games at 7:15 p.m.

League by-weeks are: 5/29 (Memorial Day, 6/5 (Monday after Play Day), 7/3 (4th of July), and 9/4 (Labor Day).

Items of note:

- A full set of rules will be available on the SFEA intranet site.
- Depending on the number of teams, there may be two divisions/seasons.
- Dates are subject to change based on team participation.
- In the event of multiple rainouts, the season may be truncated and a full-league playoff instated.
- Repeated forfeits may disqualify a team from further league play.
- SFEA participation rules will be strictly enforced.
- *High school age dependents are not eligible for post-season awards.

Enrollment closes April 6th. The enrollment fee is \$10 per SFEA player (\$12 per guest). One check per team is required (unless signing up individually). All enrollments and fees should be received in the Corporate Activities Office, SA-1, by 1 p.m., or the Corporate South Activities Office, K-1, by 1 p.m. on **April 6th**. All checks should be made payable to SFEA. The Activities Office is not responsible for cash sent through the mail or late delivery of mail.
