Any SFEA member may enroll any or all dependent family members of at least high school age listed on their membership.

Matches will be played in KC10 at Corporate South.

Match Details

- Matches will consist of a best of five games; each game is played to 11 points.
- The season consists of weekly matches and with championship play in December 2019.
- Matches will be scheduled between all players within their division. Expect to play once or twice a week. The matches will be scheduled around your schedule.

There will be three divisions based on enrollment:

- A (Advanced)
- B (Intermediate)
- C (Recreational)

There will be a pre-season practice session will be held the week of September 23, 2019. This will allow new players to determine which division is appropriate for their level of play.

Table Tennis season will run from **September 30, 2019 through mid-December 2019.**

- Matches will be played on weekdays beginning at 5:30 pm and Saturday mornings beginning at 10:30am.
 - Advanced league plays on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
 - Intermediate league plays on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.
- Recreational league plays as desired with no set schedule.

Balls will be provided, but you must provide your own paddle. League fee is \$5 per player.

Enrollment for recreational league can be at any time, but for the Intermediate and Advanced leagues, enrollments must be received by the close date. All correctly completed enrollment forms and money must be received in the Corporate HRSS/Activities Office, A-1, or employees may use the drop off mailbox inside the entrance to Human Resources (A-1) from the Atrium no later than **September 18**. Make checks payable to SFEA.

NOTE: The Activities Office is no longer accepting cash, checks only.
