

Retiree New Card Announcement

If you, your spouse, and/or eligible dependents would like access to State Farm Park, new park cards must be requested via the [Retiree Park Card Request form](#) on the Goldtimer's website.

- Three to five weeks after you submit this form, you will be notified by email that your new card is ready to be picked up at the State Farm Park gatehouse. Please return your existing Lifetime Activities cards for recycling when you pick up your new cards.
- The new park cards are valid for one year from the date of issue. You will have to submit a new request each year for continued access to State Farm park.
- Retirees, retiree spouses and dependents age 16 and above will be required to show their government-issued photo ID in addition to their park card to enter the park.

All of the following are eligible for a park card allowing access to State Farm park:

- Retiree's spouse
- Retiree's unmarried children under the age of 24 living in the household. Membership runs through December of the year they turn 24.
- Dependents living in the household for whom the retiree is a legal guardian. Proof of legal guardianship may be requested.
