- After April 1, 2019, your Lifetime Activities cards and spouse/dependent SFEA cards will no longer allow you to enter State Farm Park or other State Farm facilities. For access to the park, see the document above on Park card request. Next year when your card expires, the information on getting a new card can be found in the pull down menu on the top left called "SFEA". Please only submit this form one time! We are experiencing a high volume of requests and submitting a second form will only cause a delay. Thank you for your patience! When you pick up your cards make sure the name matches your photo ID.
